


Accessing the Old Mail Server via Web Mail

The webmail address of the old server is: <http://mail.dotnetpanels.com>

Use your e-mail address and password to login to view the mail at this location until December 31.

Accessing the New GoDaddy Web Mail



GoDaddy Webmail will be:

<https://login.secureserver.net/index.php?app=wbe>

Enter your e-mail address as the username and the default password.

Note you can change the password to anything you'd like via the webmail under Settings...Personal Settings. *If you change your password for the webmail, make sure you change it for your Outlook client if you use it on your PC.*

You can set up your Outlook or Outlook Express to download e-mail from the new GoDaddy accounts by following the directions below.

Automated Set-up

The new e-mail Mail Servers settings for Outlook will be:

Incoming (POP3) server: pop.secureserver.net

Outgoing (SMTP) server: smtpout.secureserver.net
